The planning and execution of the

17. International Young Firefighters Gathering from 19th until 26st July 2009

Under the direction of the IJLK of the CTIF and National Fire Brigades Association.

Further to the announcement of July 2008 sent to all national fire department associations, all participants are now supplied with the following instructions and enclosed documents.

Competition groups from 23 nations are registered so far.

I) DOCUMENTS

The following documents are enclosed and should be sent to the competing teams:

- \Rightarrow Participant list per group
 - The PARTICIPANT LIST is to be filled in with dates of birth (only by typewriter or word processor) and handed in at the REGISTRATION in Camp with all passports
- \Rightarrow Training plan for the <u>20. 21. July 2009</u>
- \Rightarrow Training plan for the <u>22. July 2009</u>
- \Rightarrow Competition plan for the <u>23. July 2009</u>
- \Rightarrow Age calculator for the allocation of start points
- \Rightarrow Line up for the organization of the opening and victory ceremonies
- \Rightarrow Camp rules
- \Rightarrow Illness and accident form
- \Rightarrow Program
- \Rightarrow Judges plan

The judges will be directed as previously.

II) REGISTRATION, QUARTERS

On arrival in OSTRAVA, a Registration Point has been arranged in the ČEZ ice hockey stadium.

The registration is to be undertaken with a passport. In training and competition, the passport is also to be shown.

The accommodation is located in the 3 schools near the ice hockey stadium. The allocation of accommodation is under the direction of the International Camp Administration.

The organizers have arranged for the provision of beds with mattresses, sheets and pillows. Separate sleeping arrangements will not be provided for mixed groups (girls and boys).

III) PARTICIPANTS

Once again - a group consists of **10 youngsters**, **2 supervisors**, **1 Trainer** and **1 delegation leader for young firefighters** per nation.

Each nation can bring **1 interpreter**. The interpreter's costs are met by the national fire department association of Czechoslovakia. The interpreter must, however, be registered.

<u>Only the registered participants will stay at the accommodation in the schools, resp. judges accommodation.</u>

Separate quarters and board are guaranteed for the bus drivers, providing the participation fee of EURO 165 is paid in advance by **31 May 2009**

If no payment has been received, no accommodation and no board will be available for the participants!

A copy of the counterfoil is to be produced upon registration

IV) PARTICIPATION FEES

The participation fee of **EURO 165**, for the competition participants (<u>Delegation leader</u>, <u>Judges</u>, <u>Supervisors and Youngsters as well as Bus drivers</u> is to be paid by 31 May 2009 to the bank account below

Competitors that arrive earlier or departure later have to pay the following additional costs:

The local organizers have to been informed by witting. Only the nations (groups) which have sent their dates will be taken the airport or train station in Ostrava.

Please take notice, that every nation, that needs a visa when entering the Czechoslovakia has to do the demand in time.

VI) DISPLAY and EXHIBITION

Each country is expected to give a representation of its nation through a display and performance (folklore), without the use of slides or video. These presentations will be judged by a jury and rewarded with prizes.

The registration for the Display and Exhibition of Nations was sent out with the first announcement.

For the preparation of the Displays and Exhibitions, the registration should have been sent to the German Youth Fire Brigade association.

VII) ILLNESS – ACCIDENT SHEET

The attached illness/accident sheet is to be filled in for each participant and handed in at the <u>Camp Registration</u>.

We ask every group to ask about the formalities during a hospital stag or a medical treatment in Czechoslovakia.

VIII) TROPHIES, CUPS

In the17th International Young Firefighters Competition, teams will compete for the Vetter Cup and the Lappeenranta Trophy. All teams are entered for the Vetter Cup with the top three teams receiving cash prizes.

The Lappeenranta Trophy is awarded to the highest placed team of girls.

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IX) WEARING OF UNIFORM

Best uniform is to be worn at the Camp opening, the opening and closing ceremonies of the 16th International Youth FB Competitions, as well as all official events, by the following:

X) YOUTH GROUP PENNANTS

Groups can only bring their pennants to the Camp opening and the Opening ceremony.

XI) UNIFORM HEADWEAR FOR JUDGES

The judges are asked to bring their CTIF caps received forewords in Revingen. Those who are not in possession of one can obtain one from the International Adjudicator upon payment of the appropriate fee. Members of the jury who haven't received one, will get one for free.
